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
To who to declare in Luxembourg?

✓ Paquet REACH :

“The **Minister responsible for Health** is responsible for receiving the relevant information communicated by importers and downstream users who place mixtures on the market, in particular, for formulating preventative and curative measures, in particular in the event of an emergency health response.”

✓ Since June 2015:

Declaration to the **Brussels Poison Centre**



DECLARATIONS FOR THE GRAND DUCHY OF LUXEMBOURG

Annex VIII of the CLP Regulation (EU) 2017/542 was updated on 10 January 2020 by Regulation (EU) 2020/11.

- Importers and downstream users placing on the market **mixtures for consumer use**, shall comply with this Annex **from 1 January 2021**.
- Importers and downstream users placing on the market **mixtures for professional use**, shall comply with this Annex **from 1 January 2021**.
- Importers and downstream users placing on the market **mixtures for industrial use** shall comply with this Annex **from 1 January 2024**.

Please also note that notifications made before the dates of applicability mentioned in Annex VIII and which are not in accordance with this Annex, are valid until 1 January 2025.

Since June 2015, the public and the health professionals of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg have access to the Belgian Poison Center via the free number (+352) 8002-5500.

In order to answer the calls adequately, the medical doctors of the Poison Centre need to have access to the ingredients of the products on the Luxembourg market.

In application of the article 45 of the European regulation [UE 1272/2008](#), the Belgian Poison Centre can receive the ingredients of dangerous mixtures, including biocides, on the Luxembourg market.

The data needed are similar to those for the products on the Belgian market.
